NOTES & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please report to the information tent just inside the main gate at arrival to find your tent or to set up your own tent in the Artisans Alley. It is not far from the parking lot to the tents and an entrance very close to the tents may be arranged if necessary.

All displays must be ready to open by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday July 25th, 2009 and 9 a.m. on Sunday July 26th, 2009, until 6pm.

No vehicular traffic will be permitted on the grounds after 10:00 a.m. on Saturday July 26th and before 6:00 p.m. on Sunday July 26th, 2009.

The Aldergrove Fair Days organizers require all displays to be visually appealing (no tarps, garbage, etc).

All signage should be neat and easy to read. The Aldergrove Fair Days organizers reserve the right to censor displays.

The Aldergrove Fair Days organizers will promptly close any booth which, at the sole discretion of Fair Days management, is inappropriate, hazardous, or in violation of Fair Days rules and regulations including those established by the Health and Fire Departments.

All garbage must be removed following the Fair Days.

Security will be on-site outside of Fair Days operating hours. Although security is provided, the Aldergrove Fair Days organizers assume no responsibility for any damage or theft of any properties.

We strongly recommend you obtain insurance to cover your activities at the Fair. Your household or business insurance may already provide coverage for loss, damage and public liability, however you need to check. By filling out the registration form, you agree to hold harmless the Aldergrove Fair and it's contributing organizations from public and personal liability for your activities at the Fair.
